

**Town of Northumberland
Public hearing
February 8, 2018**

Supervisor Willard Peck called the Public Hearing on proposed Local Law #1 of 2018 @ 7:00 PM. Those attending were Supervisor Willard Peck; Councilman Paul Bolesh; Councilman John DeLisle and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant. Councilman George Hodgson was absent. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy and Town Attorney Douglas Ward.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to get the public's comments on proposed Local Law #1 of 2018 –

A Local Law amending Local Law #2 of 2008

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Northumberland as follows:

Section 4: **EXEMPTION LIMITATIONS**

“Add”

(D) The exemption authorized by this chapter shall apply to qualifying owners of qualifying real property for as long as they remain qualifying owners.

Section 5: **SEVERABILITY**

“Add”

(A) The invalidity of any clause, sentence, paragraph or provision of this Local Law shall not invalidate any other clause, sentence, paragraph or part thereof.

Section 6: **EFFECTIVE DATE**

The Local Law shall take effect immediately.

There were no comments from the public. Councilman John DeLisle made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing @ 7:09 PM. Councilman Paul Bolesh seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
