Public Hearing

Supervisor Willard Peck called the Public Hearing on the proposed 2018 Town Budget @ 7:00 PM. Those attending included Councilman Paul Bolesh; Councilman George Hodgson and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant. Councilman John DeLisle was absent. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy.

Supervisor Willard Peck stated that pursuant to Section 108 of the Town Law, the proposed salaries of the following town officers are hereby specified as follows:

Supervisor \$14,325.00
Town Councilman (4) \$4,785.00
Superintendent of Highway \$57,630.00
Town Clerk \$44,047.00
Justices (2) \$8,051.00

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive comments from the public. Supervisor Willard Peck stated that the proposed 2018 is below the Tax Cap. Supervisor Peck stated that Sales Tax has been lower for 2017 than originally projected and may continue into 2018. Supervisor Peck stated that he added \$1,000 for Emergency/Disaster Service (DA8760.4) for things like cots and sheets in case the town hall needs to be used.

Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion to adjourn the public hearing @ 7:04 PM. Councilman George Hodgson seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
