

**Town of Northumberland

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive comments on proposed Local Law #1 of the year 2019 A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 1 of the year 2009. The Local Law reads as follows:

The Town Board hereby repeals Section 2 of the Local Law No. #1 of the year 2009 in its entirety and replaces it with the following Section 2:

SECTION 2. ELIGIBILITY OF TOWN ATTORNEY

Subdivision 1 of Section 23 of the Town Law is hereby amended and superseded in its application to the Town of Northumberland to provide that the Town Attorney of the Town of Northumberland at the time of his/her appointment(s) and throughout his/her term of office need not be an elector of the Town of Northumberland so long as he/she is a resident of the County of Saratoga or any adjoining County of the State of New York.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Supervisor Willard Peck opened the Public Hearing for comments. There were no comments from the public.

Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion to close the Public Hearing @ 7:08 PM. Councilwoman Patricia Bryant seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
