

**Town of Northumberland  
Public Hearing  
March 6, 2008**

The Public Hearing was called to order @ 7:00 PM by Supervisor Willard Peck. Following the salute to the flag, roll call was taken. Those attending were Councilman Paul Bolesh, Councilman George Hodgson, Councilman Patricia Bryant and Supervisor Willard Peck. Councilman Daniel Gale was absent. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive comments from the public regarding Local Law #1 of 2008 – A Local Law Amending Town of Northumberland Subdivision Regulations and Design and Construction Standards.

Supervisor Peck gave a overview of the changes: Roadway Construction/Section 2.4 shall be amended to read: Materials and construction methods for the binder course and wearing course shall conform to Section 403 of the New York State Department of Transportation Standard Specifications (NYDOTSS) dated 2006. Pavement thickness shall be at least four (4) inches after compaction. It shall be placed in two (2) courses, the first asphalt binder course two and one-half (2 ½ ) inches thick shall consist of type 3, Item No. 403.138902 (as specified in NYDOTSS §403.13) and secondly an asphalt wearing course one and one-half (1 ½) inches thick shall consist of type 6, Item 403.178902 (as specified in NYDOTSS §403.16)

Supervisor Peck indicated there are also changes in Section 2.1 Drawing – Town of Northumberland Standard Road Cross Section and Section 2.1.1 Drawing – Alternate Road Section.

There were no questions from the public. Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing @ 7:15 PM. Councilman George Hodgson seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
