Public Hearing

Supervisor Willard Peck called the Public Hearing on proposed Local Law #3 of 2009 – A Local Law continuing a temporary moratorium on the further consideration or approval by the Northumberland Town Planning Board of any proposed construction of Cell Towers, Communication Towers or Antennas, to order @ 7:15 PM. Those attending included Councilman Paul Bolesh, Councilman Daniel Gale and Supervisor Willard Peck. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy. Councilman George Hodgson and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant were absent.

There were no comments from the public. Supervisor Peck stated he had hoped to have a policy in place for the Town Board's review by now. Presently Cell Towers can only be constructed in the Industrial Zone. Town Attorney Douglas Ward has provided Board Members with some model Cell Tower Local Laws from other communities for our review. Supervisor Willard Peck stated that he would like the records to reflect that the Town Board was not taking a position for or against cell towers.

Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion @ 7:26 PM to adjourn the Public Hearing. Councilman Daniel Gale seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
