

**Town of Northumberland
Town Board Meeting
November 5, 2020**

The Public Hearing on the proposed 2021 Town Budget was called to order @ 7:00 PM by Supervisor Willard Peck. Following the salute to the flag, roll call was taken. Those attending included Supervisor Willard Peck; Councilman Paul Bolesh; Councilman George Hodgson and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant. Councilman John DeLisle was absent. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy and Building and Zoning Officer Richard Colozza.

Supervisor Willard Peck presented the proposed 2021 Town Budget plus an overview of the proposed Budget. The 2021 Town Budget is under the 2% Tax Cap. Supervisor Willard Peck stated that the proposed 2021 Town Budget is fiscally conservative. Sales Tax is estimated to be lower in 2021. Supervisor Peck stated since the Town Board paid off the new Town Hall, the amount saved will make up for the anticipated decrease in Sales Tax.

Pursuant to Section 108 of the Town Law, the proposed salaries of the following town officers are hereby specified as follows:

Councilperson (4) \$5,077.00
Superintendent of Highways \$61,158.00
Town Clerk \$46,743.00
Justices (2) \$8,415.00

There were no comments from the public.

Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion to close the Public Hearing at 7:10 AM. Councilwoman Patricia Bryant seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
