

**Town of Northumberland
Public Hearing
June 10, 2021**

Supervisor Willard Peck called the Public Hearing to order @ 7:20 PM. The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive the public's comments on A Local Law Enacting an Eight Month Moratorium on Certain Solar Energy Systems.

Supervisor Peck stated that the Town of Northumberland is considering updating the provisions of its existing Zoning Ordinance that regulate Solar Energy Systems. The current Zoning Ordinance provisions regulating Freestanding/Ground-Mounted Solar Collection Systems have resulted in applications to the Town that are inconsistent with the Town's desire to protect community agricultural character, open space, aesthetics and other resources.

There were no comments from the Public.

Town Clerk stated that this Local Law has been referred to Saratoga County Planning for their review. Saratoga County Planning will not be meeting until June 17, 2021.

Councilman John DeLisle made a motion @ 7:27 PM to adjourn the Public Hearing. Councilwoman Patricia Bryant seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
