

**Town of Northumberland
Public Hearing
November 4, 2021**

The Public Hearing on the proposed 2022 Town Budget was called to order @ 8:00 AM by Supervisor Willard Peck. Those attending included Supervisor Willard Peck; Councilman Paul Bolesh; Councilman John DeLisle; Councilman George Hodgson and Councilwoman Patricia Bryant. Also attending was Clerk Denise Murphy; Town Attorney David Brennan; Highway Supt David Coffinger and Building and Zoning Officer Richard Colozza.

Supervisor Willard Peck presented the proposed 2022 Town Budget and gave an overview of the proposed Budget. The 2022 Town Budget is under the 2% Tax Cap by roughly \$7,000. Supervisor Willard Peck stated that the proposed 2022 Town Budget is fiscally conservative.

Pursuant to Section 108 of the Town Law, the proposed salaries of the following town officers are hereby specified as follows:

Supervisor \$16,000.00
Councilperson (4) \$5,300.00
Superintendent of Highways \$63,500.00
Town Clerk \$ 52,000.00
Justices (2) \$8,800.00

There were no comments from the public.

Councilman Paul Bolesh made a motion to close the Public Hearing at 8:05 AM. Councilwoman Patricia Bryant seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
